



Caroline High School Dual Enrollment FAQ

Who can take a Dual Enrollment class?

All eligible rising 11th and 12th graders may request to take a dual enrollment class at CHS. Students must meet requirements set by both CHS and Germanna Community College, which have been modified for the 2022-2023 school year. See the chart below. In certain cases, exceptional rising 10th graders may be considered for Dual Enrollment. Interested rising 10th graders should speak to their school counselor.

How do I qualify?

For the 2022-2023 school year, qualification has been modified according to the chart above. Students who request a Dual Enrollment course will be evaluated based on A) successful completion of pre-requisite courses, and B) cumulative GPA. Students need only qualify once; that is, if a student has previously qualified for a Dual Enrollment course, they do not need to qualify again.

How do I register for the course?

First-time qualifiers for Dual Enrollment will receive instructions on completing an application to Germanna Community College. This must be completed no later than May 20th, 2022. *All* Dual Enrollment students must complete a parental consent form, emailed to the parent/guardian after the application is complete and the following information is sent to Mr. Schuyler at <u>rschuyler@ccps.us</u> – 7-digit Germanna ID number, student's *PERSONAL* email, parent/guardian's email.

How do Dual Enrollment credits work? What about tuition?

Dual Enrollment students earn both high school and college credits. High school credits are weighted by a full GPA point. Students must earn a semester grade of C or better to advance to the second half of the year-long sequence. See the chart below for a breakdown of crediting policies. **Please note that grades earned in Dual Enrollment courses are reflected on both the high school** *and* **college transcript.** Germanna Community College does not weight credits. Dual Enrollment courses are colleges and universities will count towards the student's college GPA according to that college or university's policies.

Dual Enrollment courses at CHS cost \$64 per *Germanna* credit, or \$49 per *Germanna* credit for students with free or reduced lunch (rates are from 2021-2022 and are subject to change.) Half of the year's tuition will be due at the beginning of each semester, at the end of the third week of classes. Students may elect to pay the full year's tuition in the fall if they so choose. Structured payment plans are available.
